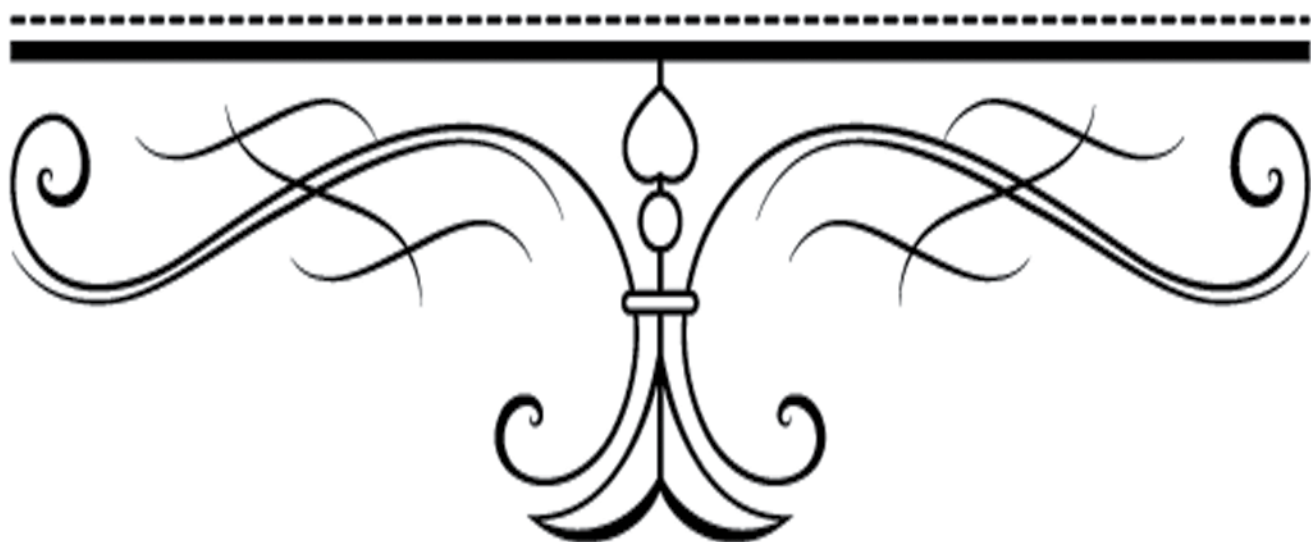
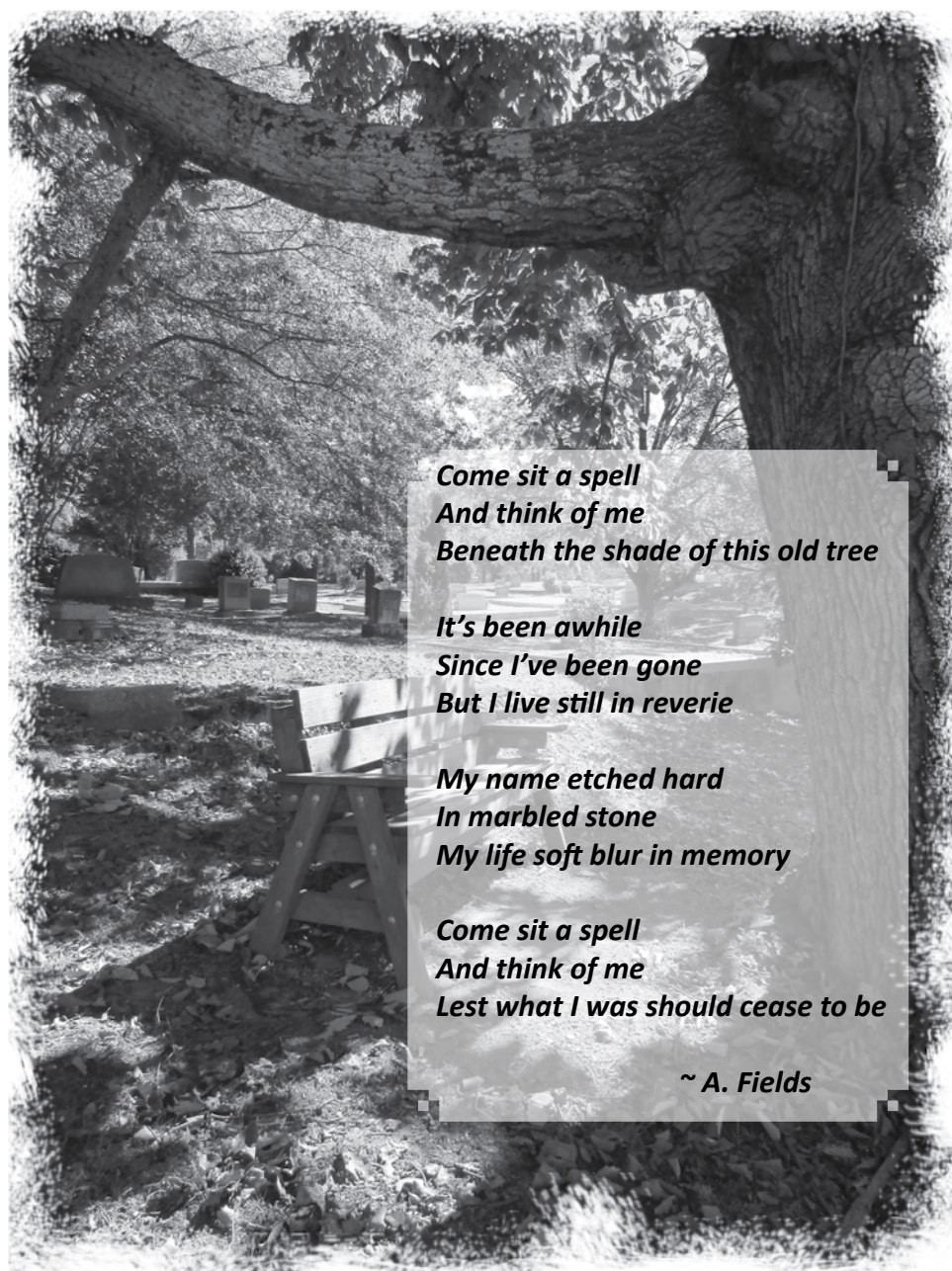

DULUTH CHURCH CEMETERY

The Duluth Church Cemetery is a great repository of the history of Duluth, as told by the markers and inscriptions of its many residents and others who are buried there. By compiling this directory the hope is that families will be able to access the graves and the inscriptions on them, as well as locating them. While a time consuming task, the work done of this project represents a labor of love and appreciation for the people of Duluth who made its history come alive during this process. Many times, as these records were being transcribed, memories of families and individuals came to mind, which often brought a smile to my face and a fond memory to my mind.

Just like the cemetery this document also has a history of its own. A catalog or directory of the entire cemetery has been done on two previous occasions. Noted Atlanta historian, Franklin M. Garrett surveyed over 750 cemeteries in the Atlanta area, including this cemetery and created the "Franklin Garrett Atlanta Necrology" - a database which can be accessed at www.garrett.atlantahistorycenter.com. Garrett's work is limited to the names of white men over 21 years old, and their female counterparts, who died between 1857 and 1931.

In 2003, Phillip Anglin transcribed all the known graves and markers within the Duluth Church Cemetery. His work, along with that of Mr. Garrett, provided a basis for this directory, and the writer is greatly indebted to these two men for their incredible works, which provide the majority of the information included in this directory. This directory was updated for all marked graves as of December 31, 2016.

This directory was revised with the primary goal of making it more user friendly. It includes all individual graves and family lots, in a fashion which is designed to allow you to locate a grave as easily as possible, and to also access the inscriptions on each and every marker. Family lots are defined as a clearly marked area, which contains more than two gravesites.

This effort was made with the intent of honoring each and every person and family buried in the Duluth Church Cemetery, however, despite all efforts at editing the data, some errors will no doubt be noted, so please excuse any such oversights or mistakes. My only regret is that despite every effort, the system used could not be made even more user friendly, but the layout and the scope of the cemetery does not lend itself to a simple process. But hopefully you will be able to negotiate through the documents and find and make use of the information included.

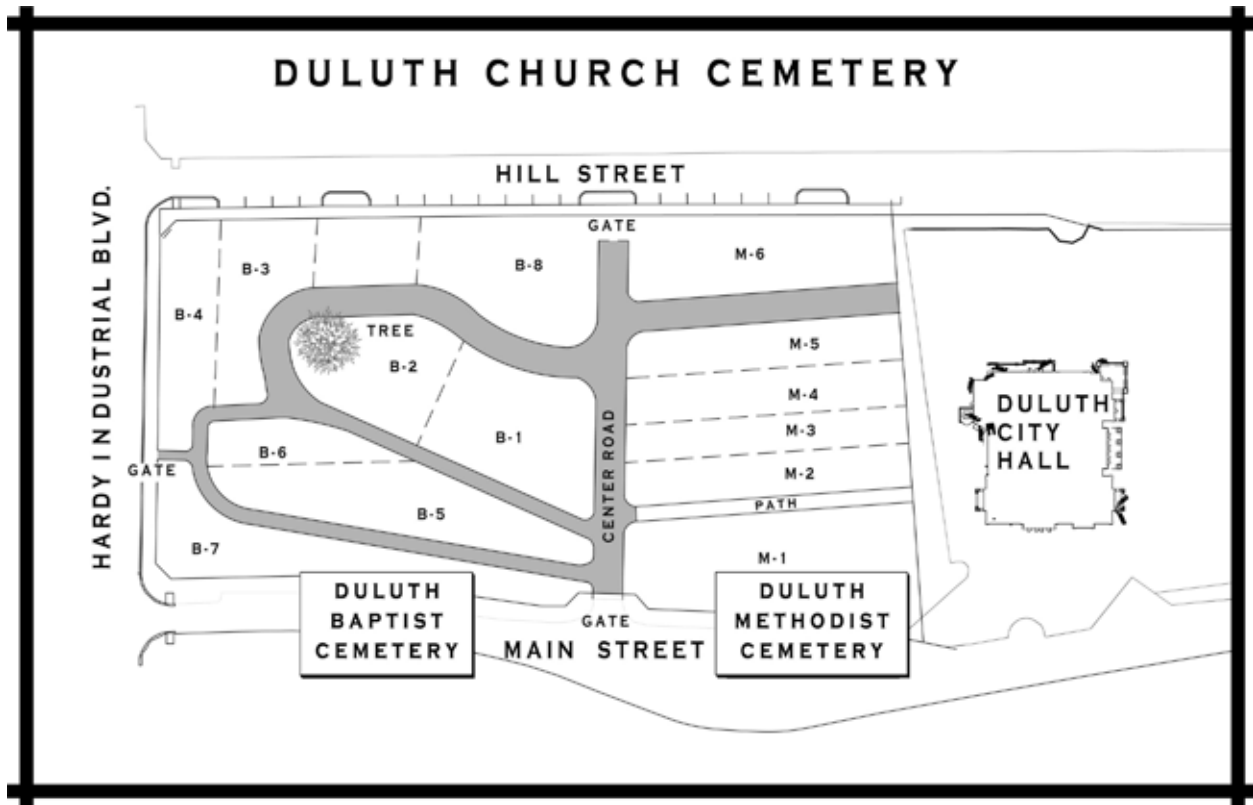

BRIEF HISTORY OF DULUTH

Following the removal of the Indians in the early 1800's, the first known white settler in the area now known as Duluth, was Evan Howell. Arriving here in 1821 and settling on the banks of the Chattahoochee River, his holdings eventually covered over 2,000 acres. He soon began trying to attract other settlers. At that time Peachtree Road, built in 1812, was the only road in the area. He obtained permission from Gwinnett County to build a road from the Chattahoochee River, across his land, toward Lawrenceville. When it was completed in 1833 the place where it intersected Peachtree Road became known as Howell's Cross Roads, a name it kept for almost 40 years. Other families moved in and Evan Howell opened a ferry where his road crossed the Chattahoochee, operated a cotton gin and a plantation, and became the town's first merchant.

There are no descendants here now with the Howell name. However, Evan Howell was the great grandfather of the late Calvin and Jack Parsons, so many of his descendants are still here in the Parsons family. Where he had built his home in the early 1800's, over 1 1/2 centuries later, developer Scott Hudgens would have his home on the same site. Mr. Hudgens kept the Howell name alive in Duluth by his many projects in the area which carry that name. Other families had great influence on Duluth as well. Among those were the Rogers, Summerour's, Knox's, Strickland's, Bell's, and others.

Farming was the chief means of livelihood during these years. With the defeat of the South in the Civil War, and the end of slave labor, land owners could no longer maintain the large plantations. They gave way to small farms, often run by tenant farmers, but cotton, as always, was still the main crop. In 1871 the coming of the railroad made Howell's Cross Roads the shipping center for much of the surrounding area. At the depot dedication the grandson of Evan Howell was asked to give the town a new name. He chose the name Duluth, from Duluth, Minnesota which was also trying to get a

railroad at that time. For years after this, during the fall, the streets were lined with bales of cotton waiting to be shipped out by railroad. This also made it a trading center, and the farmers and their families from all around spent their Saturdays in Duluth, buying from the local merchants and socializing with each other.

Singleton Howell, the son of Evan Howell, donated land for the first church in the same year that the railroad was established. Duluth Methodist Church was organized in 1871, and the Baptist Church in 1886. The town's first school was built in the mid 1870's on land also donated by Singleton Howell. In 1925 a brick building replaced the original school. It was destroyed by fire in 1935, but a new building was completed the following year. Duluth High School was built in 1958, B.B. Harris Elementary School in 1966, followed by many others through the years.

The Bank of Duluth, opened in 1904 in Downtown Duluth. The bank was forced to close during the depression, but was reorganized in 1945 in the original building. Gwinnett Community Bank is an outgrowth of that first bank today. Gwinnett's first hospital was built in Duluth in 1944. Joan Glancy Hospital, which later became a part of Gwinnett Hospital System, was responsible for much of the growth and advancement of the community. This has continued with the new hospital in 2006, Gwinnett Medical Center - Duluth, and it is a vital part of Duluth today.

Duluth has changed a great deal from the little cotton town of the 1800's. However, it has a determination to be more than just another suburb of Atlanta. Through its churches, citizens efforts, such as Duluth Fall Festival, local businesses, community activities around the Town Green, etc. Duluth has continued to maintain the closeness and small town spirit that has been felt here for generations.

HISTORY OF DULUTH CEMETERY

The land for the Methodist cemetery, consisting of two acres, was donated in 1871 by Singleton Howell, son of the founder of Duluth, Evan Howell. Ironically Singleton died in 1878 and was the first person actually buried there. There are a number of older graves, but they were moved there in later years. Those were originally in other church cemeteries, or in family plots, which were very typical in earlier years. Evan Howell, and other Howell family members, were moved from the Howell family cemetery near Evan Howell's home in Duluth, about the turn of the century. This was also true of some other burials on both sides of the cemetery.

The Baptist cemetery is on the next hill, separated by a twelve foot alleyway. It consists of four acres. This land was donated by Dr. E.G. Ware and J. C. New, who also donated the land for the original Baptist Church on West Lawrenceville St.

Duluth Church Cemetery, Inc. is a 501(c)3 Corporation - and includes both the Methodist and Baptist sides of the cemetery. For years the only churches in Duluth were the Methodist and the Baptist. Many of the people who are responsible for the development and growth of Duluth and of the two churches are buried in these cemeteries. All upkeep inside the cemetery is led by the church cemetery committee, with some funding by the two churches. Both churches pay equally into a fund that pays for cutting the grass during the spring and summer. Saturday clean-up days are held in the spring and in the fall. Notices go out to cemetery volunteers and usually from 30 to 50 people turn

out to help. After this a barbecue lunch is held for the volunteers.

The old Methodist Church now stands at the end of the Baptist portion of the cemetery. It was built in 1873 on the spot where Duluth City Hall stands now. It served as the Methodist church until 1961, when the congregation moved to the present location on Hwy 120. Several on the committee grew up in this church. The Masons purchased it later for \$10,000 to serve as the Masonic Lodge. In the late 1990's it was purchased from them by the City of Duluth, and moved to its present location. Plans were that it will be turned into some type of community center later. The new Duluth City Hall was then built on the property.

The beautiful fence and wall around the cemetery were funded by the City of Duluth in 2000 with SPLOST funds. This was part of Phase One of the Master Plan for Downtown Duluth, which included the Town Green. These projects were all designed by Mack Cain, a Landscape Architect, who is responsible for much of the beauty in Downtown Duluth.

The small white concrete building at the edge of the cemetery is the Calaboose. It was built in 1909 for \$500 and served as Duluth's jail until the mid 1950's. When Main Street was redone in the early 2000's it was split into two sections to preserve this bit of history. It is opened to visitors in September every year during the Duluth Fall Festival.

HISTORY OF DULUTH METHODIST CHURCH

Duluth Methodist Church has a long history, dating back to 1871. This was the same year that the railroad was opened through this area, and the name of the town was changed from Howells Cross Roads to Duluth. That year a small group met in the home of Singleton Howell, son of Evan Howell, the town's founder, to start a church. It had been the idea of J.W. Knox, later Mayor of Duluth, and many of his descendants are still members. These few people established the community's first church, Duluth Methodist Episcopal Church South. The name was changed to Duluth Methodist Church in 1939 when Southern and Northern Methodist churches came back together. Then in 1968, when other Methodist divisions merged, it became Duluth United Methodist Church, and later First was added to this name.

The group met for two years in the Howell home, and in 1873 moved into the new church building that was on land donated by Mr. Howell. He also gave the adjoining land for the cemetery, and the land for Duluth's first school. In 1921 additions were built on both sides of the building, for six Sunday school rooms that could be opened to expand the sanctuary. In 1954 an annex was added, consisting of a fellowship hall, a kitchen, and the first indoor bathrooms.

The church did not have a full time minister until the 1950's. Before this a minister was shared with other small Methodist churches called a 'Charge'. When I was growing up we were grouped with Warsaw and Mt. Carmel. Quarterly conferences of the 'Charge' met jointly every three months, always including 'dinner on the ground'. Services at each church were held on alternate Sundays or in the afternoons.

The Baptist Church also did not have a full time minister, so like Methodists had 'preaching' only twice a month. Methodist and Baptists met on alternate Sundays, so many families, such as mine, attended the other church on their off Sundays, so the two churches were very close. However, Sunday School was held at both churches every Sunday, and for years week long revivals were held twice a year at both churches.

By the late 1950's the Methodist membership had outgrown the facilities, and plans were made for a new building. Nine acres of land was donated by Calvin Parsons, with the cooperation of Bobby Jones and Jack Sharpton in 1959. The building was completed and the congregation moved into the new facilities in 1961. The original building was sold to the Duluth Masonic Order in 1966, and served this group until it was purchased by the City in the late 1900's to build Duluth's new City Hall on the site.

In 1963 a new parsonage was built behind the church, replacing one that dated back to 1942, after the original parsonage burned. The debt for the new building and parsonage was paid off in only seven years. A Sunday School addition was built in 1975, and another in 1983. The sanctuary, Gathering Room, kitchen, etc. were completed in 1990. Other additions were made during the next few years, culminating in 2005 with The Family Life Center.

Duluth First United Methodist Church has come a long way from that first meeting in 1871. Under the leadership of sixty one pastors it has grown from a group of only 9 people to over 3000 members today. Yet we feel that it still has that same friendly, small town feeling that has been such an important part of our church throughout the years.

HISTORY OF DULUTH BAPTIST CHURCH

Duluth Baptist Church was organized on February 13, 1886 with fifteen charter members, Julia Flowers, Henreitta Vaughn, Amanda E. Gorman, Sara McKinney, Agnes Pittard, Lou Scoggins, Sara Maddox, Julia A. New, J.L. Vaughn, Ansel Morgan, J.M. McKinney, E.M. Pittard, Thomas E. Gorman, Emory Flowers, and J.C. New. The council of ministers who participated in the organizational meeting, were D.S. McCurry, moderator; B.F. Coolege, clerk; Reverends W.J. Pirkle, J.N. Tribble, Albert Ellis, and E.J. McDaniel.

The original building was built on what is now West Lawrenceville Street at a cost of \$ 500 on land donated by J.C. New. Originally as was customary, the congregation met for worship once a month, although Sunday School and afternoon activities were added over time. By 1901, early church records show a membership of 85. The original building was destroyed by fire on July 21, 1947. While they met in the local school, the congregation used \$ 1,500 in insurance proceeds and \$ 3,500 in war bonds, to begin the task of building another church building. Church member, Frank Mattison, supervised the construction, much of which was done by members who also donated material for the building. Mr. Mattison oversaw the purchase, transportation and construction of a solid granite building with the material brought in from Elberton, GA. This distinctive building was completed in 1950, and a parsonage was also built from granite shortly after that.

After purchasing additional property across W. Lawrenceville St. to accommodate the growth of the church, a visionary step occurred with the purchase of 16.5 acres on Highway 120 in 1975. In 1979, the congregation voted to relocate the church to the new property, and sold the downtown property to the City of Duluth, for its city hall. In 1980, a multi-purpose family life center and educational building were finished and the church moved to the new site. In 1988, a 1,000 seat worship center was constructed, and later office and other educational space was added.

After many years of growth, the demographics changed of the area had changed dramatically with corresponding changes in the churches congregation. Still, the church continued to have an active ministry in the community, and expanded its mission efforts by sponsoring new church plants, including one in Duluth, MN, others in Mexico and in India. In 2010 the church began to reassess its vision for the community, which had by this time had become very multi-cultural with over 50 languages spoken in the local high school. As a result, the church's mission was defined --"To be a united community of faith, that loves, reaches and disciples all people for Jesus Christ" and began the process of becoming a church which was reflective of the diversity of its community. In 2017, the worship center was ringed with the flags of 41 countries, representing the birth nations of its members.

Note: Following the Civil War, the United States government later recognized both Union and Confederate soldiers as veterans, which allowed them to receive veteran's benefits. Many Confederate soldiers took oaths pledging their allegiance to the United States.

Special thanks to the UDC and to Dan Bennett, a Duluth native and Civil War historian, who helped with the identification of these Confederate Veterans.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many people are buried in the cemetery?

As of December 31, 2016, there are 1,117 marked grave sites within the Duluth Church Cemetery 545 in the Methodist portion and 572 in the Baptist portion. It should be noted that the actual number of people buried here cannot be fully known as some markers are memorial markers only, and some are marked for individuals still living. In addition, there are many marked family lots, several unmarked lots, and numerous unmarked gravesites.

What are the oldest graves In the cemetery?

Within the cemetery there are death dates before 1900 for 53 people—50 in the Methodist portion and 3 in the Baptist portion. This number does not include known sites which are memorial markers only.

On the Methodist side, Singleton Howell, the cemetery donor, who died in 1878, was the first person buried there. However, there are also is a marked graves for his brother, Evan Howell, who died in 1868, and whose grave was relocated here some years later. Also there are marked graves for H.O. Howell showing a death date of 1959, and one for A.B. Strickland with a date of 1837, although it is not known if they are actually buried there. Also, there are two gravesites with markers for Effiah Jane Park Howell, one which is not legible, and one which shows a death date of 1850.

In the Baptist section, the oldest death date is for Lonnie New who died in 1892. Other pre-1900 death dates are for Rowena Emily Ware who died in 1896, and for Julia Catherine Street New, who died in 1898. They are the wives of the two Baptist cemetery donors, J.C. New and Dr. E.G. Ware.

What are the oldest birthdates in the cemetery?

Within the Methodist section, the oldest birth date on a marker in is for Evan Howell, who was born in 1782, On the Baptist side, the earliest birth date is 1824 for Julia Catherine Street New. Her husband, J.C. New, one of the cemetery donors, was born in 1826.

Who are the oldest people buried in the cemetery?

In the Methodist section, Gladys Westbrook Knox, 101 years old (December 26, 1910-October 28, 2012, and Daisy Maxwell, 100 years old (May 20, 1896-December 21, 1896).

In the Baptist section, Geneva O'Kelly McDaniel lived to be 111 years old (August 26, 1887-April 5, 1999)

What is the land size of the cemetery?

The entire cemetery covers approximately 6 acres, made up of 2 acres in the Methodist section and 4 acres in the Baptist section.

Who owns the cemetery property? Who takes care of the maintenance ?

The real estate is owned by the churches—Duluth United Methodist Church and First Baptist Church of Duluth. The cemetery is maintained by a volunteer group under the Duluth Church Cemetery, Inc.—a Georgia 501-C3 corporation. All gifts to the cemetery are tax deductible.

How many veterans are buried in the cemetery?

There are 69 marked graves for veterans of the United States military. Undoubtedly there are many graves of veterans which are not marked as such.

The cemetery also has graves of 35 Confederate veterans of the Civil War.

Two graves are marked for veterans who gave their lives in World War II—Singleton T. (Tim) Maxwell and John C. Tatum

For a list of all veterans buried in the cemetery, see a separate page in the appendix listing each one by name and branch of service.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are there graves of historical significance in the Duluth Church Cemetery?

Although all who are buried in the cemetery are significant in their own right, the follow graves or markers are note worthy:

- Evan Howell-Founder of Duluth (formerly Howell's Crossroads)
- Singleton Howell— Methodist Cemetery Donor
- Effiah Jane Park Howell, wife of Judge Clark Howell (owner of the Atlanta Constitution, and mother of Captain Evan P. Howell who gave Duluth it's name in 1871.

- J.C. New- donor of the Baptist Church cemetery and the site of the original Baptist Church on West Lawrenceville St.

- Dr.E. G. Ware –Baptist Cemetery Donor
- James Hamilton Ware, Sr.- son of Dr.E.G. Ware and Missionary to China and Hawaii for 40 years.
- Dowis Family Marker – includes information on the 19 children of W.C. and Hannah Dowis
